



Not attending the Golf Tournament? Come join the WSP team for a tour of the Laughlin-Bullhead City Bridge Project. The project is being delivered through Clark County Public Works with cooperation through U. S. Federal Highway Administration, the Nevada Department of Transportation, Bullhead City, U.S. Coast Guard, U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, U.S. Department of the Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service, Arizona Game and Fish Department, Nevada Division of State Lands, Arizona State Land Department, Nevada Division of Environmental Protection. Arizona Department of Environmental Quality. Construction oversight for the project is provided by WSP, 4LEAF Consulting, Aztech Materials Testing, Newfields Environmental, Ninyo & Moore, and VTN. This project is being constructed by Fisher Sand and Gravel and is expected to be complete by May 2024.

The Laughlin-Bullhead City Bridge consists of a five-span 724-foot-long precast girder bridge on a tangent alignment with 31.5-degree skews to the Colorado River. It is being constructed to carry four lanes of traffic and a multi-use path.
